
MORE ABOUT IDEA

As a workshop, an idea factory **AksIDEA** is ready to work for the city!









Moreover, the social media presence of Woodlife Sweden in Turkey was managed by us. The project also includes the initiative and planning of the creative platform that will be active throughout the year.


The target audience of the project is the young people who will build the cities of the future that continue their education in Architecture, Interior Architecture and Environmental Design, City and Regional Planning.

The aim is to develop a detailed perspective as part of the launch event of the project, #NewEuropeanBauhausWeek. For this reason, Aks plans to produce with a focus on Europe and Turkey, based on a progress that connects the past and the present. For these reasons, the activity would be operated with a process design divided into three stages: past, present and future. Online talks and instant work shops based on these themes are planned to be either face-to-face or online.











Subway Tag Project October 2020

Today, subway transportation is one of the indispensable parts of modern cities. One of the most widely used mode of transportation in Ankara is the subway system. It transports an average of more than one hundred thousand passengers per day. (Source: EGO) This data shows that one of the important channels for connection the people living in the city is the subway. With the project it is envisaged that the cultural assets of Ankara, which are either known or unknown, and worth promoting, will be placed in the handles in the subways.

1923 yılında mimar Vedat Tek tarafından Cumhuriyet Halk Fırkası Mahfeli olarak tasarlanan ve inşa edilen bu bina işlevi değiştirilerek meclis olarak kullanılmıştır. Bodrum üzerine iki katlı olan bu yapının iç bölümleri, iki kat boyunca yükselen ortadaki meclis salonunun üç kenarına dizilmişlerdir. Cirişten sonra enine uzanan, iki ucunda merdivenlerin yer aldığı geniş geçit, Selçuklu ve Osmanlı bezeme motiflerinin yer aldığı bir tavanla örtülmüştür.

Su Perileri, Cumhutiyetin ilk yıllarında İtalya'dan Ankara'ya getirilmiş olon ve günümüzde Cer Modem'in önünde sergilenen bronz heykeldir. İlk olarak Kızılay Meydanı'na yerleştirilen heykel şehir geliştikçe farklı konumlara taşınmıştır. 1992 yılında geçici olarak kaldırıları heykel Büyükşehir Belediyesi'nin Park ve Bahçeler Müdürlüğü deposuna deposuna götürülmüştür. 18 yıl depoda bekledikten sonra 2008 yılında hasar gören kısımları heykeltıraş Metin Yurdanur tarafından restore edilerek şu anki yerini



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It is aimed to include the important architectural work in Ankara on the front, short sections from literary works on Ankara and brief information about some of the works exhibited in the museums on the back of the handles under the auspices of the Ministry of Culture and Tourism in Ankara.







Gençlik Parkı Activity Area Summer - Fall 2020

While the "Gençlik Parkı Activity Area" was being designed, multifunctional zones were created so that the young population could easily use the area for culture and art activities. The aim was to increase the interaction with the city by strengthening the visual connections of the area with Anıtkabir. Decks defined around the oak tree that are created at different levels from each other respond to the needs of the users as sitting units and possible study spots. The L shaped units located next to them were designed as a seating area for the stage. A mini stage and installations were implemented in the space defined by a pergola.

On the map that introduces Ankara's landmarks, natural beauties, historical and cultural values; sightseeing routes for local and foreign tourists who will visit the city have also been shown.





It is aimed that the buildings determined for the events will be experienced with the 20 or more participants daily, with the architects of the building or academicians who have produced academic studies on that structure.


